The Duration of the State of Emergency Declared in the Entire Country has been Extended by Six months in Accordance with Section 425 of the State Constitution of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar



At the meeting 2/2023 of the National Defence and Security Council of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, the members of the NDSC including the Pro Tem President released a statement of extending the duration of the state of emergency declared in the entire country for six months as of 1st August, 2023 in accordance with section 425 of the State constitution of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar because the extraordinary circumstances of the unlawful attempts to seize State power by terrorist organizations through violent and terrorist means have been occurring although the State Administration Council has been ex-

erting efforts for stability and all-round development of the country.



- 1. Meeting 2/2023 of the National Defence and Security Council of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar was held at 09:30 am on 31st July, 2023. At the meeting, Commander-in-Chief of Defence Services Senior General Min Aung Hlaing reported on the situations relating to the new five-point Roadmap and 12 objectives of the State adopted by the SAC on 4 February 2023 to undertake the development of the State in momentum and implement quickly the two national tasks and two political tasks during the extended six-month period, the enhancement of socioeconomic lives in the State due to the proper implementation of roadmap and objectives, the acts of terrorism being committed by NUG, CRPH and their proxy PDF terrorist organizations, the terror acts aiming to disrupt the education sector of the country although the government has been making efforts to enhance the education sector in the country, the arrests of the said terrorists due to the tip-off given by the conscientious people, the fulfillment of the government to develop the agricultural and livestock farming based MSME businesses, the rise of GDP of the State in the respective financial years and expectation to increase the GDP of the State in the 2023-2024 FY, the enactment of the Political Parties Registration Law and needs of security measures to be taken for the political parties, the holding of discussions with the Ethnic Armed Organizations (EAOs) of NCAsignatories and non-signatories to restore perpetual peace, and holding of peace talks to be continued, the voter frauds occurred in 2020 General Election, the census collecting procedures that is primary to ensure the correct voter lists and such procedures delayed due to the attacks of the terrorists, the proper preparations before the cyclone "Mocha" in advance, the relief, rescue and rehabilitation activities after the storm, the necessary security measures to be taken for the preparation and holding of elections.
- 2. Over the report of the Commander-in-Chief of Defence Services, the members of the NDSC held discussions together. Members of the NDSC including the Pro Tem



President, expressed their views that although the State Administration Council has been exerting efforts for stability and all-round development of the country, the CRPH, the NUG and their proxy PDF terrorists have been murdering innocent people, blasting public places, committing acts of terrorism on the education sector of the country aiming to enable the people to have poor education in various ways and means, and conducting bomb blasts on roads, bridges and railways being used by public. Moreover, the said terrorist organizations are still not only attempting to disrupt the peace and stability, and rule of law of the State, but also threatening the public, in addition to, are also trying to seize the State power through violent and terrorist means. Moreover, they also expressed their opinions that the political parties are still requiring the time for preparation to hold the elections, and facing security threats while they conduct the organizational tasks, the census collecting procedures are underway for ensuring the correct voter lists, and the necessary security measures are still necessary for holding free and fair election without fears. Therefore, they expressed their views that the needed length of time should be determined. Based on the consensus decisions made by all members of the National Defence and Security Council who attended meeting, the Commander-in-Chief of Defence Services will be able to accomplish the assigned duties only when the duration of the state of emergency is extended and thus the duration of the state of emergency declared in the entire country has been extended by six months as of 1st August, 2023 in accordance with section 425 of the State Constitution of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, and a statement issued by the Constitutional Tribunal of the Union on 1 February 2023.

3. It is here announced that the meeting was attended by Pro Tem President U Myint Swe, Vice-President U Henry Van Thio, Speaker of the Pyithu Hluttaw U T Khun Myat, Commander-in-Chief of Defence Services Senior General Min Aung Hlaing, Deputy Commander-in-Chief of Defence Services Commander-in-Chief (Army) Vice-Senior General Soe Win, Union Minister for Defence General Mya Tun Oo, Union Minister for Home Affairs Lt-Gen Soe Htut, Union Minister for Foreign Affairs U Than Swe, Union Minister for Border Affairs Lt-Gen Tun Tun Naung and those who were invited on the

Clarification on Completion of Building Maravijaya Buddha Image which would be World's Highest Sitting Marble Buddha Image Held





A ceremony to explain the progress in building the Maravijaya Buddha Image which would be the world's tallest sitting marble Buddha image, located in Dekkhinathiri Township of Nay Pyi Taw Union Territory, was held on 29 July.

Present were Chief of General Staff (Army, Navy and Air) General Maung Maung Aye, senior military officers from the Office of the Commander-in-Chief, Nay Pyi Taw Command Commander and officials, donors and distinguished guests.

First, the leading donor the SAC Chairman Prime Minister Senior General Min Aung Hlaing explained the following points regarding the building of the Maravijaya

Buddha Image and the Park:

- The systematic stage-by-stage excavation of huge boulders that would be carved into Maravijaya Buddha Image;
- The preparations to carve the Buddha image in Bhumi Phassa Mudra in Yadanabon era;
- The conveyance of the parts of the Image and the Throne in different phases by waterway and road amidst many difficulties, and the world's heaviest conveyance in waterway and road transport records;
- The phase-by-phase implementation of Maravijaya Buddha Park project;



- The Ovada sought from State Sangha Maha Nayaka Sayadaws for the comprehensive inclusion of pagodas, temples, lake, ordination hall, rest houses, bridges and park in building the Image and the Park;
- The using of modern machines in inscribing the Sixth Buddhist Synod version of Pail and Romanized Pitaka treatises on stone tablets as a center for learning the treatises in accord with the counsel of Oavadacarira Sayadaws;
- The publishing of treatises in Pali and Romanized languages for distribution to monasteries of foreign countries and inserting them into the tablets;
- The construction of Vijayabhumi Nimmana Land of Victory in the facing direction of the Maravijaya Buddha Image;
- The systematic calculations for the durability of the Maravijaya Buddha Image;
- The carving of the parts of the Image with the use of CNC machine;
- The part-by-part connection of the parts

- of the Throne, and the construction of fountain square and circular fountains;
- The construction of Maravijaya Temple and Mucalinda Lake, and planting of kyee trees;
- The success in connecting parts 1,2 and 3 of the Image and lifting up them by the concerted efforts of the Myanmar Engineering Council and the Military Engineers using advanced machinery;
- Gala ceremonies to enshrine sacred objects in the reliquaries on the bejewelled Throne;
- The construction of Sasana Beikman Agga Dipati Withongama ordination hall which is 296 feet long, 213 feet wide and 94 feet high to organize grand religious ceremonies;
- The coating of the Image and installation of Uññalun holy hair on the face of the Buddha image;
- The systematic calculation with the use of modern technologies in providing the Image with wind-resistance, earthquake-



resistance, natural disaster-resistance for its durability;

- The construction of the pagoda platform and gandhakuti chambers;
- The planting of Maha Bodhi tree and sal tree, and establishment of a mini forest; and
- The preparations for organizing the gala consecration ceremony, and portrayal of the Image construction project after its completion.

Then, those present at the ceremony generously donated cash to the fund for building the Buddha Image and the park. Therefore, the leading donor the SAC Chairman Prime Minister Senior General Min Aung Hlaing accepted the cash donations. Then, the Senior General spoke words of thanks for collective contributions.

Chairman of State Administration Council Prime Minister Senior General Min Aung Hlaing Attends and Delivers a Speech at Economic Committee Meeting 6/2023 of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar



The Economic Committee Meeting 6/2023 of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar took place at meeting hall of the SAC Chairman Office on 26 July. The Chairman of the State Administration Council (SAC) Prime Minister Senior General Min Aung Hlaing attended the meeting and delivered an address. First, the Senior General delivered opening remarks as follows:

- The incomes of the State comprise three portions: ordinary income, loans and cash assistance. After taking the State responsibilities, the government did not borrow any loans.
- In its term, the government restricts the selling of natural resources as much as it can. Hence, the government is striving for manufacturing more products to promote the State economy.
- The GDP of the State increased to 3.4 per cent in the 2022-23 financial year, and it is expected to secure four per cent of GDP in the 2023-24 financial year.

- If the country emphasizes current manufacturing measures, greater development will come out. As a result, the downtrend status of the economy could escape in 2020-2021 financial year.
- Regarding the utilization of farmlands, as cultivable lands are being used on other ways, it cause loss to the State agricultural tasks of the country.
- Therefore, it is necessary to correctly manage land utilization under the prescribed laws.
- As cooking oil is imported abroad to meet the local oil demand yearly, it spends a large sum of foreign exchange. Hence, encouragement is being given to cultivation of oil crops.
- The Economic Committee must take accountability for the government, and the government for the State Administration Council, and the SAC for the country.
- The economic committee is urged to em-

phasize discussions on promotion of the State economy.

Then, Secretary of the economic committee Union Minister U Win Shein of the Ministry of Planning and Finance, union ministers, and region and state chief ministers reported on their respective sectors. After hearing the reports, the SAC Chairman Prime Minister instructed the officials as follows:

- In trade sector, only when there are manufacturing industries, will export goods be available and it is necessary to boost production. Research on the international market must be conducted constantly to get access to the export markets for agricultural and livestock products of the country.
- Respective ministries are required to take measures to fully run their operations.
- The K20,000 banknote aims to be circulated as a commemorative measure. New

- K20,000 banknotes will be issued within the set limits.
- The government does not have deficits as well as money circulation has struck a balance between revenue and spending. Therefore, the country will not surely face inflation for the circulation of K20,000 banknotes.

The meeting was also attended by council members Admiral Tin Aung San, Lt-Gen Moe Myint Tun, U Shwe Kyein and U Maung Ko, Union ministers, Union level officials, deputy ministers and officials. The region and state chief ministers joined the meeting through videoconferencing.

Vice-Chairman of State Administration Council Deputy Prime Minister Vice-Senior General Soe Win Attends and Delivers a Speech at Meeting 4/2023 of Illegal Trade Eradication Steering Committee



The Illegal Trade Eradication Steering Committee held its 4/2023 Work Coordination Committee at the Nyilarkhan Hall of the Ministry of Commerce in Nay Pyi Taw on 27 July, and it was attended by the Vice-Chairman of the State Administration Council (SAC) Deputy Prime Minister Vice-Senior General Soe Win, in his capacity as the Chairman of the Committee. During the meeting, the SAC Vice-Chairman delivered an address as follows:

- During the period from January 2022 to June 2023, the approximate value of seized illegal commodities amounted to K127.054 billion in 7,011 cases, registering a significant increase when compared with the previous years. But, the illegal trade did not decline and also still exists.
- According to the statistics on Myanmar-Thai trade from May 2022 to April 2023, the statistics of Thailand mentioned the export value worth US\$2.932 billion but

- Myanmar statistics for import value, US\$1.293 billion, which showed US\$1.639 billion differences. So, it can be reviewed that these would be illegal trades within a year.
- Based on the country's conditions, the presence of border areas still need security in the country due to the large number of illegal crossing points and illegal routes along the long border lines, and staff strength who involve in anti-illegal trade activities and corruption. As illegal commodities still flow into the country due to the weakness of such conditions, it is necessary to check and seize illegal commodities at warehouses and markets.
- The illegal trade and natural resources smuggling business still exist in the country so that the special task forces on anti-illegal trade activities are urged to effectively curb illegal trade, and take legal action against them.

- The teams should check the trade centres, checkpoints and security gates in the relevant regions and states to ensure that there were no bribery and unnecessary delays. If a bribery case is exposed, persons at all levels involved in it will be dealt with severe punishment.
- The officials have to strictly supervise the functions of checkpoints and security gates not to commit bribery cases.
- In reviewing the seizures in June 2023, according to the reviews on commodity groups, the monthly balance of the seizures amounted to K11.816 billion and the vehicle group K7.822 billion, exceeding K4.254 billion rather than the previous month but seizures of agricultural produce, timbers, raw materials, personal goods, foodstuffs and live animals declined.
- The officials concerned are urged to implement the e-lock system that enables to check the containers, closed vans and commodity transport as quickly as possible.
- chines will be used in inspecting the commodities rather than manual inspection, it will help increase seizure volume and contribute to smooth trade process without wasting time. As such, the Customs Department needs to observe searching and inspection processes of neighbouring countries and international community to improve the process at home.

- Some developed countries use some staff in trade process on a wider scale due to betterment of the techniques.
- It is necessary to check and ban illegal trade goods to be taken action at border regions and trade routes as well as warehouses and markets.
- Chairmen of special task forces and departmental officials have to specially supervise unacceptable costs and delay measures at the gates along the trade routes.
- It is also necessary to replace staff strength with modern machinery as quickly as possible. In combating illegal trade, special task forces and one-stop service (OSS) departments need to cooperate with each other.

Therefore, those present at the meeting reported on their respective sectors of the combating illegal trade while the leader of the task force read out the draft resolution of the 4/2023 committee meeting. Later, the SAC Vice-Chairman Deputy Prime Minister coordinated the reports and discussions, following the meeting successfully finished.

Also present were Union Ministers Lt-Gen Soe Htut, U Win Shein and U Aung Naing Oo, deputy ministers, members of Nay Pyi Taw Council, Chairman of Revenue Appellate Tribunal, permanent-secretaries, directors-general, and officials. Chairmen of region and state illegal trade eradication special teams attended it through videoconferencing.





Oo, deputy staff officer of the township agricultural department who was teaching as a substitute teacher at the Institute on 22 July. They then took him to a palm oil farm east of his house and shot him dead using small arms.

It is reported that security personnel are taking necessary measures to arrest the PDF terrorists who abducted a principal and teachers and killed a deputy staff officer. The perpetrators of terrorists will be taken punitive actions as per existing laws.

PDF terrorists abducted the female principal of the Institute of Agricultural Institute (Dawei) and her 11-year-old son together with five teachers from Sakhangyi Village of Launglon Township in Taninthayi Region on 20 July. Moreover, those PDF terrorists shot dead a deputy staff officer from Launglon Township Agriculture Department who was lecturing agricultural techniques at the institute, on 22 July. In this regards, 19 local organizations issued statements on such brutal attacks as follows:

- The Young Men's Buddhist Association (Central), All Myanmar Hindu Central Council, All Myanmar Theravada Buddhists Federation and Sasana Nuggaha Association for Border and Hilly Regions (Central), and Myanmar War Veterans Organization issued the statements that the abducting and killling the civil servants who are not military target, committed by the terrorists with the dogma "people who differ from my attitude are my enemies", are the inhumane acts. Therefore, they strongly condemned such acts of terrorism.
- Myanmar Interfaith Dialogue Group (Central), Myanmar Theatrical Association (Central), Myanmar Writers' Association, Myanmar Motion Picture Organization, Myanmar Artists and Sculptors Association (Central), Myanmar Music Association (Central), Pinnaygone Yakhine Jaame Mosque,

- Sanatan Dharma Swayamsevak Sangh, All Myanmar Tamil Hindu Foundation (HQ), The Methodist Church (Lower Myanmar), Islamic Religious Affairs Council Myanmar and Myanmar Evangelical Christian Alliance also issued the statements that they strongly condemned the brutal acts of terrorism committed by NUG and PDFs.
- Myanmar Press Council issued a statement that it would not absolutely accept
