Chairman of State Administration Council Prime Minister Senior General Min Aung Hlaing Attends and Delivers a Speech at Meeting 7/2023 of Union Government



The Meeting 7/2023 of the Union Government was held at the State Administration Council Chairman Office in Nay Pyi Taw on 4 December. The Chairman of the State Administration Council (SAC) Prime Minister Senior General Min Aung Hlaing attended the meeting and delivered a speech as follows:

- Some of the monsoon crops are now at the harvesting stage. As a result of the region/state wise efforts, crop production increased, but still needed to hit the target.
- If coffee cultivation can be extended as the set plan, there will be a significant growth in coffee production within the coming five years.
- Regarding the rubber cultivation, regions and states place rubber on 1.6 million

- acres of land. As rubber product is a sure product, it can be used in manufacturing the proper products. So, regions and states need to encourage cultivation of rubber.
- According to the monetary assets in banks of the country, the private ownership is the largest. If the ownership can be spent on agriculture and livestock industries for the sake of the State and the people, businesspersons, employees, the State and the people will have benefits.
- In the previous era, tax collection amount increased in regions and states.
 As revenue is spent on the development of the nation, it is necessary to collect tax.
- In this regard, tax rate should not be increased but tax space must be expanded.



- Sanctions were imposed to Myanmar to face difficulties of foreign currency, harming banking system. As such, it is necessary to increase export volume to earn foreign currency with raising the domestic production.
- The government since its establishment has been managing exportation measures. In this regard, prices of fuel and cooking oil are controlled.
- But unscrupulous persons committed rising of cooking oil for causing difficulties to the people. Effective action was taken against those unscrupulous persons for their committed acts under the law.
- Some reviewed that manufacturing weakness is based on high prices of inputs but businesspersons are not interested in manufacturing sector depending on the profits that they will gain.
- Despite having less profits, large production can earn profits. So, the government allows rubber businesspersons to spend 70 percent of the export earnings in or-

- der to easily import fertilizers and other inputs for agriculture and livestock farms
- Agriculture based MSMEs must be encouraged. As different regions manufacture different products, products that are suitable for the region must be encouraged to be successfully produced.
- MSMEs based on natural products such as wood, bamboo, rattan and other materials. We need to think about penetrating not only domestic but also foreign markets.
- In carrying out the MSME businesses, it is necessary to make sure One Region One Product. We also need to think comprehensively until they can penetrate not only the domestic market but also the overseas market.
- Regarding basic education, except for the areas where there is a conflict, 100 percent school attendance is seen in the remaining areas. As well as teachers, rel-

evant local governments, state and regional officials need to work together in administrative and security measures.

- We acknowledge the teachers from the Ministry of Education who are working in the field of teaching amid the difficulties. We also praise the health workers for providing healthcare to the local people.
- From the time of the Tatmadaw government to date, development undertakings reversed the situation of Rakhine State with remarkable improvement.
- However, AA armed organization commit to instability in the condition of development undertakings. Now, AA armed organization attempts to cause armed terrorism in MraukU, Kyauktaw and Paletwa regions.
- Such conflicts will bring bad consequences to residents, and their sabotage will cause loss and damage to bridges, roads, buildings and ancient cultural heritages provided by the government within a short time.
- Although now is the time to carry out development tasks in their region, valuable time was spent on reconstructing damaged bridges and roads and rehabilitation tasks with a large sum of funds.
- Due to KNPP and KNDF terrorists, clashes happened in the Loikaw region of Kayah State in last year. When the ar-

- ea was stable, residents rehabilitated and reconstructed with their funds.
- Now, terror acts of KNPP groups have destroyed houses and buildings in Loikaw, so it is challenging to carry out rehabilitation tasks.
- If armed organizations keep on being foolish, residents of the relevant regions will suffer bad impacts. So, it is necessary to consider the lives of the people, and those organizations need to solve their problems politically, discarding their naughty moves.
- The Union system that we are moving forward is based on democracy and federalism, and it includes all the points they are asking for.
- Our Three Main National Causes: nondisintegration of the Union, nondisintegration of national solidarity and perpetuation of sovereignty are being implemented with the national concept.
- Such conflicts in the country can harm the State economy as well as the tourism sector. Only when the country is peaceful and stable in political and security measures, will inbound and outbound tourism industries boom.

Then, the Union Ministers at the meeting reported on sector-wise matters, and the Senior General gave necessary instructions on their reports, following the meeting concluded.

Also present were SAC Vice-Chairman Deputy Prime Minister Vice-Senior General Soe Win, union ministers and officials. The Nay Pyi Taw Council chair and chief ministers from regions and states attended the meeting through videoconferencing.

 Matters pertaining to the international issues and ASEAN issues, lesser pro-




spects to control the world by a single powerful country due to the change from the unipolar to the multipolar in the international arena, prospects of various countries in cooperation;

State Administration Council Information Team Leader Maj-Gen Zaw Min Tun Makes Clarifications on the Current Situation in Myanmar



The State Administration Council (SAC)
Information Team Leader MajGen Zaw Min Tun made clarifications on
the ongoing situation in the country on 4
and 5 December as follows;

- Russian Federation President Mr. Vladimir Putin conferred the Order of Alexander Nevsky on Chairman of the State Administration Council Prime Minister Senior General Min Aung Hlaing. Similarly, the SAC Chairman Prime Minister Senior General Min Aung Hlaing conferred the honorary title of Thray Sithu on Mr. Nikolai Patrushev, Secretary of the Security Council of the Russian Federation.
- Former soldiers who have been allowed to retire from the army, those who have been absent without leave and those who have deserted their units come to express their wish to serve in the army again if

- they are allowed through sending letters to concerned commanding officers and meeting in-person with them.
- Those who have been absent without leave and those who have deserted their units will be admitted to enlist at the concerned units and/or nearest military units again under the regulations of the specified period. The proposed former soldiers who commit ordinary crimes will be granted a pardon.
- Under the law, military desertion is generally an unauthorized absence without the intention of returning to the army. If they have wishes to return to the army and serve in the military, it can be said that desertion is not consummated.
- If those, who have been declared as absence without leave, return to the units for serving in the army will not be con-

- sidered as desertion, but only as an unauthorized absence, and the soldiers will be admitted for military service.

It is learnt that the report describes PDF terrorists were responsible for 57 percent of acts of violence in Myanmar and KNLA and KNDF groups committed 14 percent of the acts of violence.
- As those terrorist groups are doing acts of utter devastation of the state, the international community should work together to end acts of violence in Myanmar.
- Armed clashes are breaking out in Namhkam and Laukkai areas of northern Shan State, in Kawkareik in Kayin State, at Pauk Taw police station in Rakhine State, in Tigyaing of Sagaing Region and in Mone of Bago Region.
- Some subversive media created fabrication and are making propaganda on social media platforms that some 1,500

- KNLA and PDF terrorists captured the Mone town on 3 December following their attacks on local military units in Mone and a bridge at the entrance of the town.
- In reality, terrorist groups withdrew in disorder due to the gallant fight of officers, other ranks and family members of the military unit and close air strikes.
 Then, the Tatmadaw military columns took control of the town and are taking security measures.
- The Government will inevitably pursue its goal to establish a federal system based on the multi-party democratic system and the Union system.

Since the national defence is the duty of every citizen, all citizens are required to safeguard our country in unity, it is reported.



PDF Members with no Crime Records Returning Legal Fold Entrusted to their Parents



The ceremony of entrusting PDF members, who had completed trainings in the areas of some EAOs and returned to legal fold without committing any crime, to their respective parents has been holding at the Anawrahta hall of Central Command on 4 December as follows:

• A total of five PDF members from Myitnge township of Mandalay region and Myaing township of Sagaing region, with two homemade guns, ten bullets of 9 mm, four magazines and related items were handed over to the security forces and returned to legal fold. 1,000,000 Kyats were given for two homemade guns.

At present, the Government has wel-

comed the people who returned to the legal fold and provided them with necessary assistance as well as cash rewards for delivering up their weapons and ammunition to concerned authorities. Accordingly, many people who are willing to return to the legal fold still remain, and nearest township and district administration bodies, military units and police stations will admit them if they make contact with the said-bodies as early as possible. Up to 4 December 2023, a total of 711 persons including 557 males and 154 females have already returned to legal fold, it is reported.

Myanmar Transfers Illegal Immigrants from Border Areas to Respective Authorities



The government has been focusing on State peace, stability and rule of law. As some foreign nationals are illegally entering and residing in Myanmar through border areas, administrative organizations conduct necessary investigation process and repatriate them to relevant countries under the law. In this regard:

- On 4 December, a total of 127 Chinese individuals (115 men and 12 women) were identified and handed over.
- On 5 December, a total of 104 Chinese individuals (92 men and 12 women) were identified and handed over.
- Between 31 October and 5 December

2023, a total of 11,183 Chinese nationals (9,962 men and 1,221 women) have been verified under the law, and transferred systematically to the authorities of the People's Republic of China.

The government will continue the process of screening and repatriation for foreign nationals who have illegally entered and resided in the border areas, it is reported.

- The news stating that Non-CDM civil servants in Kawlin and Indaw resigned from their jobs is just fabricated information. In reality, they are fulfilling their duties at the workplace assigned. In fact, unlawful NUG group is threatening Non-

CDM civil servants and forcing to join CDM campaign.

Unlawful subversive media abetting to acts of terrorism are spreading such rumors in order to frighten civil servants who fulfill the state's duty and peaceable local ethnic people. The Government is continuing to take necessary measures for the peace and stability of the state as well as the prevalence of law and order, it is reported.

Tatmadaw Military Columns Wipe out KNLA and PDF Terrorists who Attack Local Military Unit in Mone Township

Since KNLA and PDF terrorists with superiority in numbers attacked a local military unit by surprise in Mone township of Bago region on 3 December, military personnel and their family members made counter-attack on them throughout 4 December. Although the terrorists had faced

lots of casualties, they fought the military unit again following reinforcement. Accordingly, the family members were evacuated to safe places by air.

On the morning of 5 December, when the Tatmadaw attacked them with the support of air and heavy weapons, the terrorists



retreated with heavy losses in the afternoon. The Tatmadaw military columns retook the local military unit where terrorists temporarily took position and conducted further security measures in Mone.


The unofficial media outlets abetting to acts of terrorism released false information that some 1,500 insurgents occupied military units, steel-framed bridge at the entrance of the town and Mone town on 3 December, aiming to impose fear in the public and disturb the stability in the area.

During the incident, dead bodies of the terrorists and some weapons were seized. Since the terrorists also arrested some military officers, other ranks and families, the Tatmadaw military column is still conducting operations to save the life of arrestees, it is reported.




PDF Terrorists Launch Drone Attack on Wedding Ceremony in Payan Village, Shwebo Township

PDF terrorists are committing acts of terrorism in townships that do not support their group such as blowing up non-military targets of public roads and bridges, shelling, making drone attacks on wards as well as villages and setting fire to residents for no reasons.

On 4 December while a wedding cer-

emony was being held at the home of U Lin Maung, a resident of Payan Village in Shwebo Township of Sagaing region, PDF terrorists taking position from Kyauk Myint village about 3,000 metres to the south of Payan Village, launched a drone attack on the house. Due to the attack, two innocent women were killed and 13 locals including
